## **Boarding Policies for Yorktown Animal Hospital, Inc**

## **Vaccination Policy:**

*Dogs*-are required to be up-to-date on the following: Rabies, DHLPP (Distemper), Bordetella (Kennel Cough), and must have had a negative stool check in the past 6 months. *Cats*-are required to be up-to-date on the following: Rabies and FVRCP (Feline Distemper)

If this is a new animal boarding request, please have written proof of vaccination at the time of admission. Animals not in accordance with the above will receive vaccinations upon admission.

## Fleas/Ticks/Intestinal Parasites:

All animals admitted to Yorktown Animal Hospital for boarding will be checked for fleas/ticks and will receive treatment at owner's expense if needed. If intestinal parasites are noted upon either gross examination or by fecal float, the pet will be treated at owner's expense. This is to ensure the health and well-being of all our patients and guests.

## **Medical Illness Policy:**

One of the advantages of boarding your pet(s) at a veterinary hospital is that veterinary attention is readily available should the need arise. If your pet(s) become ill, we will call the emergency number(s) listed on your pet's information sheet to inform the contact person of your pet's symptoms, treatment options, and estimate of additional costs. If no one can be reached however, please indicate your wishes below should your pet require treatment to relieve immediate discomfort or resolve an important medical condition.
